



Air Canada Expands its Global Network to Eastern Europe

Starting June 3, 2018 Air Canada Rouge will connect Croatia with Canada. Air Canada's leisure airline flies from Zagreb to Toronto four times a week. In addition Air Canada Rouge will connect Romania with Canada starting June 10, 2018. The new services from Bucharest to Toronto and Montreal will be offered four times a week until the beginning of October. The Toronto and Montreal hubs offer passengers smooth connections to many destinations in Canada and the US.

Air Canada Rouge operates both new routes on a Boeing 767-300. The flight time is about 10 hours. On board passengers have the choice between the two service-classes Economy and Premium Rouge. The state-of-the-art cabin features slimline seats in Economy Class for more comfort and legroom, free meals and soft drinks, and up to 23 kg of free luggage.



In Premium Rouge passengers have plenty of room to relax with wider seats and more legroom. In addition, Premium Rouge guests can check-in two pieces of luggage up to a maximum of 32 kg each, at the airport they enjoy exclusive services such as Priority Check-in and Priority Boarding and have access to the Maple Leaf Lounges at selected airports. On board Premium Rouge passengers are spoiled with an excellent on-board menu served on porcelain dishes.

Air Canada Rouge is one of the first airlines in North America to offer a Streaming Inflight Entertainment System. Passengers can pre-download the free "player" app to enjoy a wide selection of current movies, series, music, children's programs, and more on their own laptop or Apple or Android device. If required, passengers can borrow an Apple iPad for a small fee. iPads are available free of charge in the Premium Rouge cabin.
